Our Website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Website and also allows us to improve our Website. By continuing to use our Website, you agree to our use of cookies.

1. Cookies - What are They and How Do We Use Them?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or your computer's hard drive if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of the Website.

The Website uses cookies to recognize you and your preferences, enhance the performance of our website, and collect analytical information for the benefit of your experince. The term cookies include similar technologies for collecting and storing information, such as Local Shared Objects (commonly referred to as "flash cookies") and web beacons or web bugs (including transparent or clear gifs).

Session cookies allow us to track your actions during a single browser session, for example, to remember the items returned from a search. They do not remain on your device beyond your session.

Persistent cookies remain on your device between sessions and allow us to authenticate you and to remember your preferences.

The table below explains the types of cookies we use on our websites and why we use them.

Category of cookies	Why do we use these cookies
Strictly Necessary	These cookies are essential for websites on our services to perform their basic functions. These include those required to allow registered users to authenticate and perform account-related functions.
Functionality	These are used to recognize you when you return to the Website or when you have logged into the Website already. This enables us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name, and remember your preferences. For example, for Website Language settings - to keep the same language during usage of website or app.

Analytics and Performance	They allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors, track views of content, and to see how users move around the Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way the Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
Marketing	These cookies collect and analyze data on user acquisition sources, including referral links, advertisements, and marketing campaigns. They enable us to assess the effectiveness of our marketing efforts, track user journeys from external platforms, and enhance our referral programs by attributing conversions to the appropriate channels.
Targeting/ Advertising	These cookies record your visit to the Website, the pages you have visited, and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make the Website more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose. For example, we use Google Analytics which uses cookies and similar technologies, to collect and analyze information about the use of the Services and report on activities and trends. This service may also collect information regarding the use of other websites, apps, and online resources.
Third Party / Embedded Content	These include social media Websites such as Facebook and Twitter (through the use of sharing buttons), or embedded content. As a result, cookies may be set by these third parties, and used by them to track your online activity. We have no direct control over the information that is collected by these cookies.

2. Managing Cookies

If you wish to opt out of all cookies (including necessary cookies), and delete any cookies which have already been placed for this website and any other website, you can do this through your browser settings. If you choose to switch certain cookies off, it is likely to affect how

our website works. Please note that by deleting or blocking cookies that are strictly necessary for the performance of our website, it may not function correctly and you may not be able to access certain areas of the website.

3. Third-Party Cookies

- Google Accounts Used for sign-in via Google.
- Google Analytics Analyzes traffic and user behavior.
- Sentry Tracks errors on the site.
- Google PAP (Recaptcha) Protects authorization and is set by Google.
- Facebook Pixel Collects data for Facebook advertising.
- Hotjar Analyzes user movement and behavior on the site.

Optional:

 MetaMask – While MetaMask itself may set cookies, it is a browser plugin and not a service directly controlled by our site.

4. Google Analytics

Our website uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service provided by Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics works using cookies. Google Analytics cookies collect your IP address; however, because IP anonymization is used on this website, your IP address will be shortened (and therefore anonymized) as soon as technically possible and before it is stored or otherwise used in connection with Google Analytics.

We use the information collected by Google Analytics cookies to find out about how visitors use our website. Google will not combine the IP address sent by your browser in connection with Google Analytics with other data. You can prevent Google Analytics cookies from being stored by setting your browser software accordingly. You can also opt out of Google Analytics by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available at google.com.
